We are pleased to announce the final membership for each region's Selection Committee to support the application selection process of the K12 Strong Workforce Program. Membership runs from February 2019 – February 2021. We recognize that much time and energy was spent to recruit and nominate such fine candidates. We appreciate you and your Review Teams for all of your efforts.

Finally, please notify individuals who were not selected and thank them for their time and interest in this opportunity. We hope to make this opportunity available again in spring 2021.

Selection Committee Training

All Selection Committee members, including alternates, will be expected to attend or watch a recorded version of an introductory webinar scheduled for Thursday, **February 28, 2019**, from



3:30 pm – 5:00 pm. Invitations will be sent via email to all Selection Committee members and alternates on Monday, February 25, 2019. This webinar will be co-hosted by the California Community Colleges Chancellor’s Office (CCCCO) and the California Department of Education (CDE). It will provide a high-level introduction of the Selection Committee roles and responsibilities and introduce them to the online platform, NOVA, where they will read, review, and score applications.

Selection Committee members will also be expected to attend a face-to-face training hosted by each Regional Consortia. **Attendance at this training is mandatory.** We request that you plan to host this one-day event between March 4 – 15, 2019 or a time shortly thereafter. In this meeting, participants will meet all members of their region’s Selection Committee, build norms of working together, and identify a committee chairperson. They will work to calibrate the scoring of applications using a rubric and learn to navigate the NOVA platform successfully to score applications. All regional chairs will receive a suite of materials to support the facilitation of this meeting in advance.

Work Schedule for Selection Committee Members

We suggest scheduling out all of the tasks required of Selection Committee members and sharing these dates and expectations with the membership as soon as possible. Below is a suggested table of events and dates to support your work with the Selection Committee. The CCCCCO will host a weekly check in call with Selection Committee Chairpersons and the Regional Consortium designee.

Again, we thank you for all of the time and thoughtfulness you have given to recruiting and selecting such a diverse group of secondary, postsecondary, business and industry leaders. We look forward to working with your Selection Committee so that they are well prepared for their important responsibilities.
